#### Start with the Basics

- Any gaps in service history that raise suspicion?
- Any reason to suspect the mileage isn't legitimate?
- Does the title include the word "salvage"?

#### **Exterior**

- Are the wheels damaged?
- Are the windshield wipers damaged or missing?
- Do turn signals, headlamps, and brake lights work?
- Any lug nuts damaged or missing?
- Any faded paint or cracks?
- Is the trim free of damage?
- Any panels a different color?
- Any differences in gaps between body panels?

#### Exterior (Continued)

- Any cracks or chips in the windshield?
- Any evidence of damage from a previous collision?
- Any small dark spots or oily spots on the bumper near the exhaust pipe?
- Are all the tires the same size, brand, and condition?
- Any signs of rust?

#### Interior (Continued)

- Any seats that are cracked, stained, or ripped?
- Is the trim intact and free of cracks?
- Any windows go up or down slower than the others, or make a noise?
- Does the sunroof operate slowly, make sounds, or struggle to move?
- Do all accessories (windshield wipers, stereo, etc) work properly?
- Any squeaking or rattling sounds from the climate control fan?

#### Interior (Continued)

- Does the climate control fan work on all speed settings?
- Any suspicious smells that could be attributed to mold or mildew?
- Air conditioning and heat in working condition?
- Any evidence of water damage under the seats, carpet, or glove box?
- Check the spare tire. Any water damage or rust in the spare tire well?
- Are the pedals, seats, or steering wheel more worn than the odometer suggest?

#### **Under the Hood**

- Any cracks or worn places in the belts?
- Any exposed wires?
- Any cracked hoses or signs of leaks?
- Any corrosion on the battery or battery clamps?
- Is the battery more than 4 years old?
